Over 80% of trafficked people are women and girls who are often forced into prostitution. Victims of trafficking may be on your premises, make sure you know the signs and ask yourself:

- Do they speak little or no English, or have someone else speaking for them?
- Do they appear to be unhappy, frightened and controlled by someone else?
- Are there any obvious signs of physical abuse?
- Are they being treated for an STD or suspected untreated pregnancy?
- Do they seem very lonely or fearful of adults, especially law enforcers?
- Do they have difficulty giving you their address or personal details?
- Are they ever angry showing evidence of regular abuse (blackouts)?
- Do they show extreme and unusual behaviour and attitudes?

How can it happen?
Victims, usually from poorer countries are enticed to richer countries, with promises of a good job and somewhere to live. Women and girls in particular, are targeted by traffickers, offered jobs in hotels or restaurants, but in reality, they are intended for work in the sex industry.

Where are victims held?
Look for these signs in your neighbourhood:

- Unusual amount of visitors at a property nearby
- Premises frequently visited by men
- A rented house/flat which may be run down, unkempt, seem empty, curtains may be closed during the day
- Different women appear to live there for short periods of time
- Women are never seen outside alone – always accompanied

Marta's story
Marta was told a job as a waitress was waiting for her in a hotel. She was tricked at the opportunity to have a better life, went to Spain and for some time lived happily home to help her family. The reality when she arrived was very different.

Ellen's story
Ellen wasn't even offered a better life. She was simply abducted from Romania and sold to a brothel in London's West End where she was forced to have sex with up to 40 men a day. She was beaten, raped and threatened with death if she tried to refuse. Ellen was 15 years old.

If you see something you think you should report call Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111. All calls will be confidential and anonymous – and can help stamp out sex trafficking.

Loves Me Not...

- Tries to control me
- Gets violent, loses temper quickly
- Always blames me
- Is sexually demanding
- Keeps me from seeing my friends & family
- Makes all the decisions
- Embarrasses me in front of others
- Hits me
- Makes me cry
- Makes me feel afraid
- Is always 'checking up' on me
- Takes my money and other things
- Threatens to leave me if I do not do as I am told
- Teases, bullies and puts me down

If you recognise any of these signs you may be a victim of abuse. You DO NOT have to suffer alone.
