Raven Kaliana presents her autobiographical film, Hooray for Hollywood, which gives an insight into the mechanisms of human trafficking. Set within the child pornography industry, the story is shown from the child's vantage point through puppetry. The film exposes the intersection between familial abuse and organised crime, and testifies to the power of love and resilience.

A panel discussion follows the film, featuring Raven Kaliana (Outspiral,) Adam Weiss (Legal Director at The AIRE Centre - Advice on Individual Rights in Europe Centre,) and Esther Davidson (OXCAT - Oxford Community Against Trafficking.) Learn about the prevalence of these crimes within the UK, how to identify and help victims, support survivors, and protect children. The Forum will be chaired by Anita Amendra, Sustainable Communities Programme Manager, IofC UK.

Raven Kaliana is the director of Outspiral, which employs puppet-based theatre and film to raise awareness and engage the public on child pornography, trafficking, generational abuse, post-traumatic stress and healing.
